**DGN COMMUNIQUE NO. 1**

My Fellow Rotarians:

We are once more called upon to select our district's nominee for governor, this time for Rotary year 2011-2012. Under the By-laws and Manual of Procedures of Rotary International and our District Policies, the governor nominee is to be selected in a dignified and responsible manner, in accordance with the principles of Rotary, and with the end in view of seeking out the Rotarian best qualified for that office. In fulfillment of this mandate, I invite you to submit to me the following suggestions and nominees of your respective clubs:

DISTRICT NOMINATING COMMITTEE (DNC)**

Pursuant to the duty imposed on me by District Policy 5.01.5, I have directed the district's legal office to prepare the official **District 3830 Club Resolution Form for DNC Nominations** for the clubs to use in documenting their nominations for the DNC (please note that clubs with less than twenty [20] members as reflected in the latest 01 July SAR may not longer submit nominees for DNC membership). The accomplished official form should be placed in a sealed envelope and should be physically received by my office at **Intexhouse 221 Nicanor Garcia, Bel Air II, Makati City 1200**, on or before **5:00 pm of Wednesday, 11 March 2009**. This official district form may be viewed in the official district website ( <http://3830rotary2008.org/> ) and will be sent to you through email and, upon your request, fax transmission.



The clubs are advised that nominees for DNC membership should be available to serve, should they be chosen through the lottery as a regular or alternate member, from **14 to 18 March 2009** which is the five (5) day-period wherein the DNC is expected to commence and complete its proceedings. Please note that the unavailability of any DNC regular member at any time within this period, will automatically lead to the absentee's substitution by an alternate member so as not to delay the proceedings.

I have likewise requested the district legal office to prepare a **Model Club Resolution to Suggest a Rotarian as DGN** which I strongly urge all interested clubs to adopt and use in documenting their suggestions for DGN. The resolutions containing the suggestions for DGN should be received by my office on or before **5:00 pm of 11 March 2009**. This model resolution may likewise be viewed in the official district website and will be sent to you through email and, upon your request, fax transmission.

Thereafter, on **Friday, 13 March 2009**, the DNC shall be chosen by lottery from the qualified nominees submitted by the clubs. I shall then convene the DNC the very next day, **Saturday, 14 March 2009**. Once convened, the DNC shall immediately commence the process of selecting the DGN that, under existing district policies, should be completed within five (5) days. I shall announce the Governor Nominee to all District 3830 Rotarians as soon as the DNC informs me of its selection.

The district's evaluation of the nominees for DNC membership and suggestions for DGN and its handling of the lottery, shall be governed by the RI Bylaws and Code of Policies, as well as the **District Policy Manual as amended in the 2007-2008 Discon** (likewise posted in the official district website). I urge all clubs and Rotarians in the district to study these rules. To make this task easier for everyone, I have also instructed that the following simplified presentations of the applicable rules earlier prepared by the district's legal office, be posted in the district website, to wit: **(a) Guidelines for the Submission of Suggestions for DGN and Nominees for DNC Membership; and (b) DGN: Qualifications & Disqualifications.**
