



GUIDELINES
**FOR THE SUBMISSION OF SUGGESTIONS FOR DGN
AND NOMINEES FOR DNC MEMBERSHIP**

- a) Only clubs with at least twenty (20) members as reflected in the latest 01 July SAR, may submit a nominee for DNC membership. No club shall submit more than one (1) nominee for DNC membership. (*District Policy V, Sec. 5.01.2.*)
- b) Only clubs with no outstanding indebtedness to RI six (6) months immediately preceding the lottery for DNC members may submit nominations for DNC membership. As used herein, "outstanding indebtedness" means obligations unpaid for more than ninety (90) days after they fell due. (*District Policy V, Sec. 5.01.2.c.*)
- c) The club's nomination for DNC membership shall be in the official district form (**District 3830 Club Resolution Form for DNC Nominations**) duly signed by the Club President and accompanied by a certification by Club President and Club Secretary that the said Club Resolution was duly adopted during a regular club meeting where a quorum is present. Nominations not in the official form shall not be entertained. (*District Policy V, Sec. 5.01.5*)
- d) A nominee for DNC membership must be a member of the nominating club, a past president who has served a full term at the date of the DNC lottery, a Rotarian in good standing for at least 5 years also at the date of the DNC lottery, and a member of of a Rotary Club in District 3830 for the three (3) years immediately preceding the date of the DNC lottery. (*RI By-Laws, Article 13.020.4 and District Policy V, Sec. 5.01.2.*)
- e) A nominee for DNC membership must NOT have been suggested as DGN for RY 2011-2012, must NOT belong to a club that submitted a suggestion for DGN for RY 2011-2012, and must NOT have served in the both RY 2006-2007 and RY 2007-2008 DNCs (*District Policy V, Section 5.01.4.*)
- f) The club's suggestion for DGN shall also be in the form of Club Resolution (preferably the **Model Club Resolution to Suggest a Rotarian as DGN**) duly signed by the Club President and accompanied by a certification by the Club Secretary that the said Club Resolution was duly adopted during a regular club meeting. (*RI By-Laws, Article 13.020.4*)
- g) The clubs who intend to submit nominees for DNC membership are strongly encouraged to first ascertain the physical availability of their nominees to actually serve in the DNC during the five (5)- day allowed it under District Policy V, Section 5.02 to select the DGN.
