ANNOUNCEMENT OF CHALLENGE

Governor's Communiqué

My Fellow Rotarians:

I address you by authority, and in representation, of our district governor who is presently out of town on official Rotary business.

As earlier announced by the governor, **ROTARIAN BILLY VILLAREAL** of the Rotary Club of Makati EDSA was selected as District 3830 Governor Nominee (DGN) by the District Nominating Committee. However, the name of **ROTARIAN JOJI TAN** of the Rotary Club of Makati Dasmarinas has been submitted as a challenging candidate for the same position pursuant to a resolution of challenge adopted by her club.

As mandated under Article 13.020.9 of the Bylaws of Rotary International, any other club that wishes to concur with the challenge must file with the governor, not later than 5:00 PM of 13 April 2009, a resolution of concurrence that has been adopted at a regular meeting of the concurring club. The challenge will be deemed valid only if it is concurred to by at least seven (7) other qualified clubs that have each been in existence for at least a year prior to 01 July 2008.

The governor strongly urges the concurring clubs, in the interest of orderly proceedings, to see to it that the resolutions of concurrence are duly signed by the club president and secretary, and in the model form prepared by the district's legal office (copy attached hereto, and to be made available for downloading from our website).


